To prohibit the use of funds for certain parades.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preventing Allocation
- 5~ of Resources for Absurd Defense Expenditures Act" or the
- 6 "PARADE Act".
- 7 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR CERTAIN PA-
- 8 RADES.
- 9 (a) In General.—None of the funds appropriated
- 10 or otherwise made available for the Department of De-
- 11 fense or for the White House or the Executive Office of
- 12 the President may be used for a covered parade.

1	(b) COVERED PARADE.—In this section, the term
2	"covered parade" means a parade that—
3	(1) is sponsored by the Department of Defense
4	or by the White House or the Executive Office of the
5	President; and
6	(2) is not a parade that has been held to com-
7	memorate a holiday or special event during the ten-
8	year period preceding the date of the enactment of
9	this Act.
